AUDIO TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- · audio mixer with a sound engineer service
- 4 × mono channel (accoustic instruments)
- 1 × stereo channel (electronics)
- 2 × dynamic microphone to cover the gongs setup
- 2 × condenser microphone to cover the set of acoustic instruments
- quality stereo sound system with power adjusted to the space
- stage area R: empty space approx. 300 × 200 cm size
- stage area L: a table approx. 150 × 90 cm size
- · optimal stage table height: 95 cm
- 2 × stage monitors
- 6 EU power plugs
- ground lifter
- wires

VIDEO TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- digital projector with a minimum resolution of 1280 × 720 pixels, optimal resolution: 1920 × 1080 pixels
- projection screen or surface of the white wall in the background with the minimum width of 300 cm
- HDMI or VGA wire long enough to connect the source MacBook Pro from the stage table to the digital projector

This blend creates a sort of unique and intense musical space build on a strong basis and filled with many unforeseen sound events. The main objective of this project is mutual interpenetration of two acoustic and electronic sound worlds.

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
